We work to break the cycle of child abuse and neglect, supporting children as they find their voice and helping children and families heal and thrive.

DIRECTOR'S CORNER

What an incredible year ABC House experienced - full of exciting changes and some bittersweet goodbyes. After months of preparation and hard work, on February 5, 2019, we moved into our new facility in a flurry of boxes and organized chaos. Some of us didn't even have desks and no one could find the toilet paper. Getting lost on the second floor became a common occurrence.

Eight days later, we welcomed our first clients.

Despite the inauspicious beginning, our new home began delivering on its promise almost immediately, as we were better able to accommodate emergency cases and could begin to hire new staff. We added seven new, much-needed positions, and our team grew to 21 staff members. With these critical additions, we were able to serve 718 children over the past year (almost 5% more than 2018!), which was notable since services were largely on hold for three weeks during our move. Equally important, we provided care for these children in new and better ways, including more on-site services, expanded counseling options, and ongoing family support.

The most amazing part of being in the new building has been children's reactions to it, like the anxious 7-year-old whose enchantment with our sidewalk seashells gave her the confidence to walk through the front door for her assessment appointment; the 4-year-old who gave our doctor a pop quiz on all the different sea creature tiles as they walked down the hall to the exam room; and the 3-year-old who laughed with delight at the carpeted "beach" in Karly's Playroom, then promptly removed her shoes to play in the sand and insisted that our Clinical Manager remove hers as well (and she did it!).

These moments of safety and wellbeing validate what you all understood from the beginning: that it's not about the building at all. It's about what the building makes possible.

There is more work to do. Next year, we will continue growing our staff and expanding our services to more fully meet the need. With your help, we can break the cycle of abuse and give children back their childhoods. This is just the beginning.

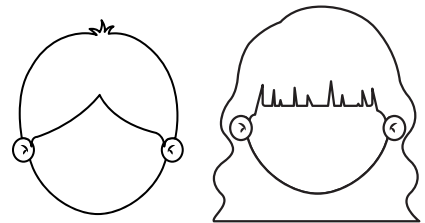

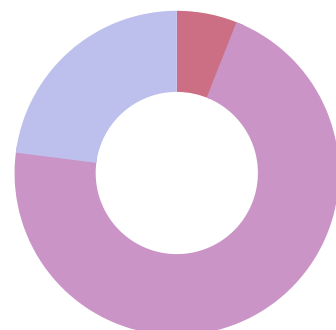

OUR SERVICES

Medical Exams & Consultations

Our physicians are child abuse experts and remain supportive, objective, and neutral throughout the child's head-to-toe exam. Any physical signs of abuse are documented and may be used as evidence in the abuse investigation. Equally important, children have the opportunity to ask questions about how the abuse may have affected their bodies and development, and to receive reassurance from our trained staff. Medical providers also offer consultations to help law enforcement and DHS caseworkers make real-time decisions about children's safety.

Forensic Interviews

Forensic interviews are legally justifiable, fact-finding interviews with a child conducted by professionals trained in talking to children to obtain accurate and objective information. The purpose of a digitally recorded forensic interview is to reduce the number of times children need to share their experience.

Family Advocacy & Support Services

Families receive support to help them cope with the discovery of abuse and navigate at a time when their lives have turned upside-down. Our Advocates provide families with information to help non-offending caregivers understand the child abuse assessment and investigation processes as well as help identify and connect them to any other needs or resources.

Trauma Counseling

ABC House counselors specialize in trauma treatment to help children and their family members process what has happened to them and move forward. Children learn strategies to help them manage their fear or feelings of being out-of-control when remembering abusive events, and to focus on their own strengths and abilities. These services are offered as long as they are needed.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION & PREVENTION

We believe that prevention education is the key to ending child abuse. ABC House offers a comprehensive community outreach program that includes a variety of training topics. Programs targeting adult professionals and community members focus on preventing, identifying, and responding to concerns of child abuse; school presentations educate students on ways to stay safer. 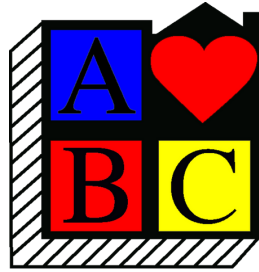

ABC House is created and located at the Lebanon Community Hospital.



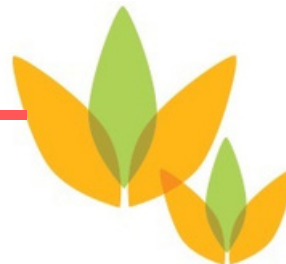
1999

The Board of ABC House votes to move forward with a capital campaign and the two-story 35-year-old commercial building at 228 SW 5th Ave in Albany is purchased as the new future home of ABC House.

The Capital Campaign Steering Committee is assembled and the quiet phase of fundraising begins.



2017

The campaign theme and materials are developed.

2018

The community phase of fundraising begins as well as the groundbreaking of the new building.



2019

In February, ABC House celebrates moving into the new building with a ribbon cutting ceremony.



With increased staffing, the new facility is enabling ABC House to better meet demand by serving more families simultaneously without compromising their confidentiality and privacy. The expansive new building features two complete assessment areas with two medical exam rooms, two interview rooms, and two waiting and quiet rooms. This allows us to conduct more medical exams and interview appointments. A dedicated and expanded counseling wing accommodates additional post-trauma therapy appointments so that more children referred with concerns of abuse will be helped without delay. The new building also features a larger training room, so community members can learn how to prevent, identify and respond to child abuse. The future is brighter for vulnerable children in Linn and Benton counties, both now and in the future, thanks to supporters like you!

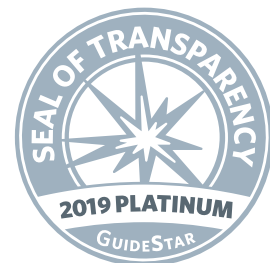
